Step 1:

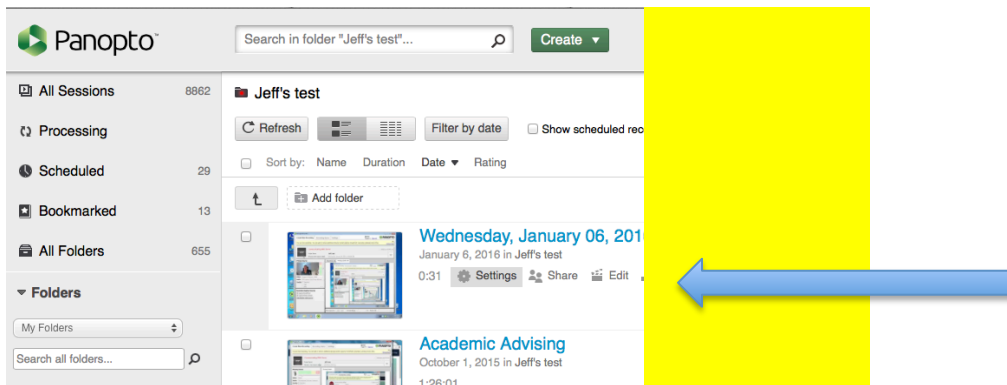
Log in to Panopto at: siu.hosted.panopto.com

Find the recording that you want to transfer

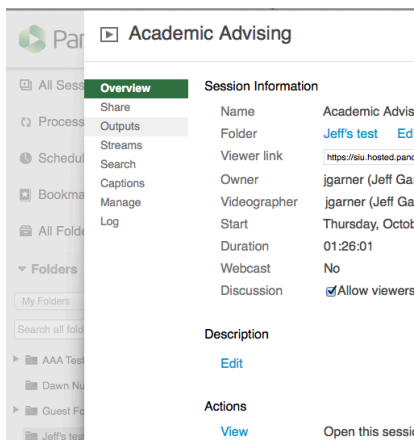
Step 3:

Step 5


From here you can choose to download as an mp3 AUDIO podcast or an mp4 VIDEO podcast.



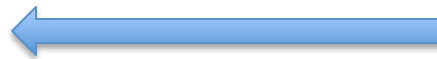

Step 6:

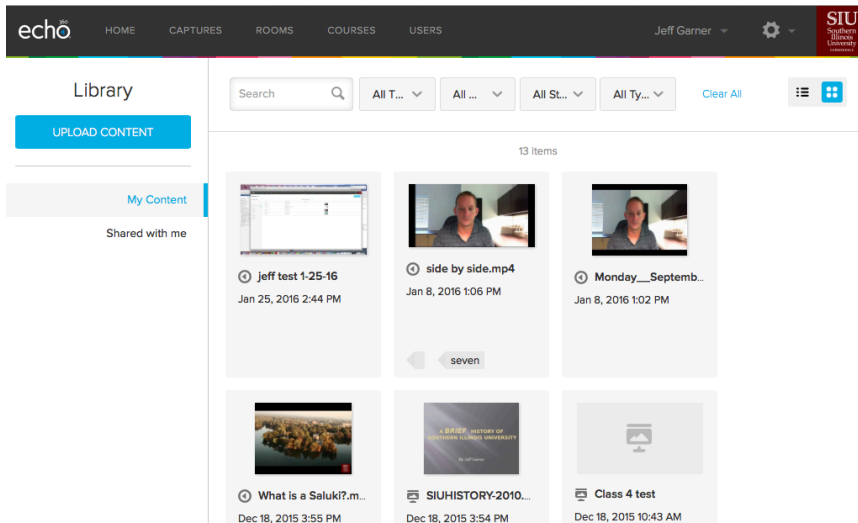
Your mp4 podcast has now been downloaded to your computer. From here, if you haven't already done so, login to your Echo360 account at echo360.org

Step 7:

Once logged in to Echo360, select the “Library” tab on the main menu bar.

Step 8:

In the Upper right hand corner you will see Library and “Upload Content” select Upload Content



Step 9:

Once selected, its just a matter of “Choosing File” or drag and drop your newly created mp4.

Step 10:

Your Panopto video is now in your Personal Library and can be accessed for any course you choose.
