

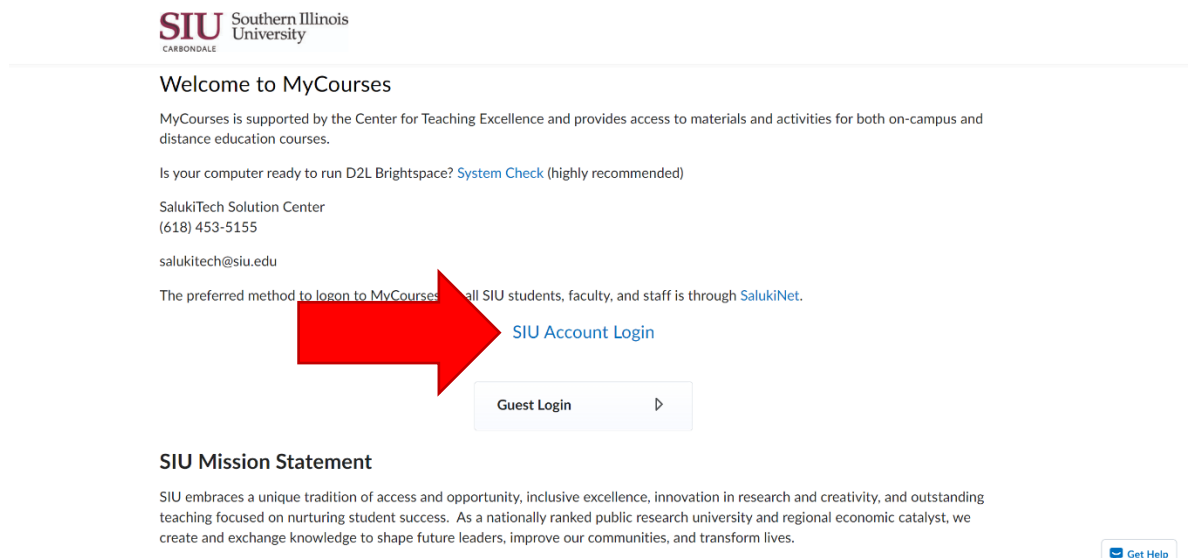
Step by Step Guide for Enrolling in the Self-Paced New Instructor Pre-Orientation Course (NIPO)

Important!

To complete this activity, you **will either need an SIU email and password or you will need to contact the CTE to obtain access (teach@siu.edu)**.

Step 1: Go to “ITA Resources” page

3. Verify your access using Duo (also obtained from SIU Office of Information Technology) [If requested]

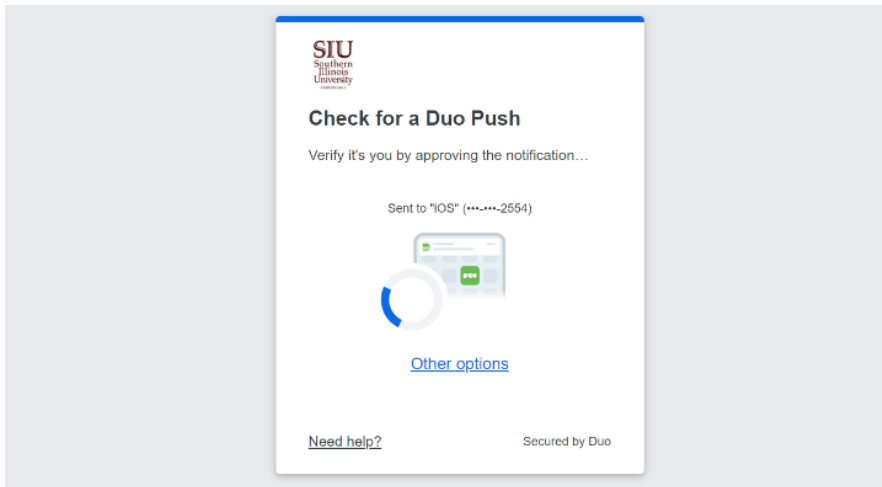


Figure 2. SIU Duo Push Authentication

1. In case you are not already enrolled for this interview, please use this guide to self-enroll. Click on the “Enroll in Course” button.

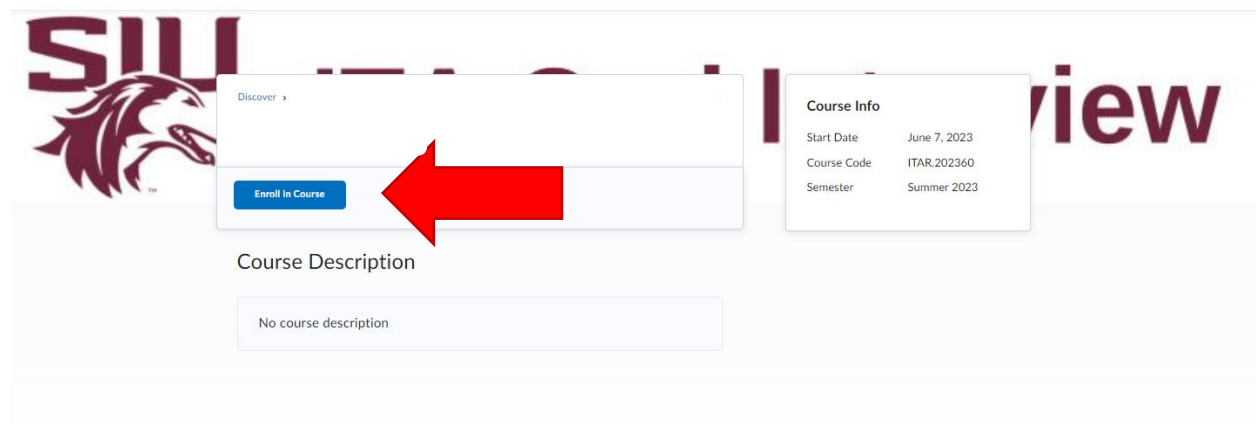


Figure 3. NIPO self-enrollment page

Step 3. Review The NIPO Course Home Page

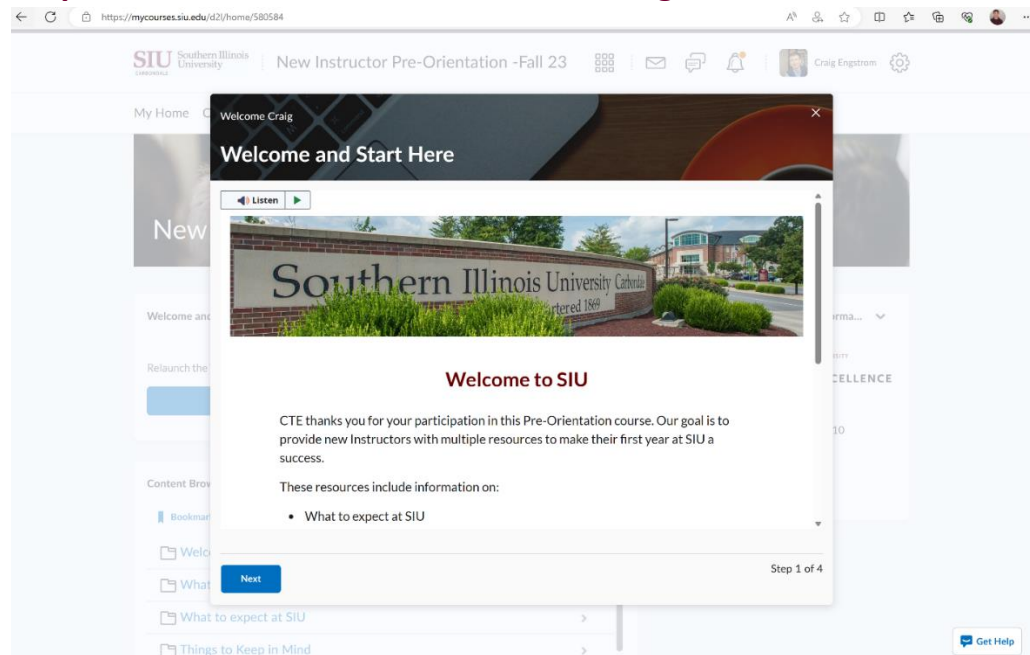


Figure 4. NIPO instruction pop-up

2. On the “NIPO” page, you will see “Content” menu; click on this to land in the main content of the training.

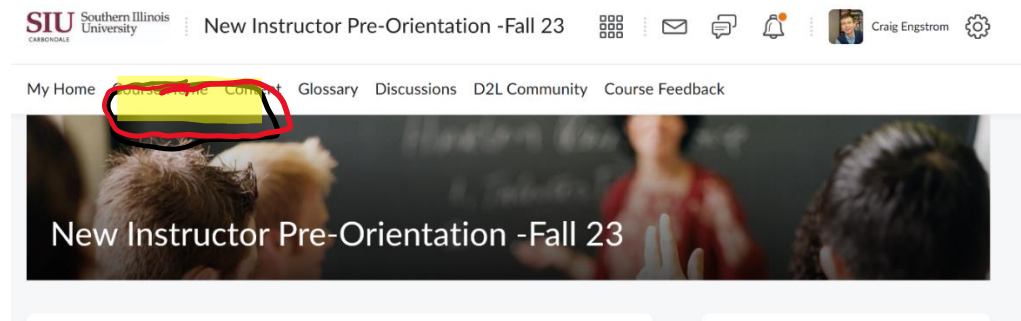


Figure 5. NIPO Content menu link
